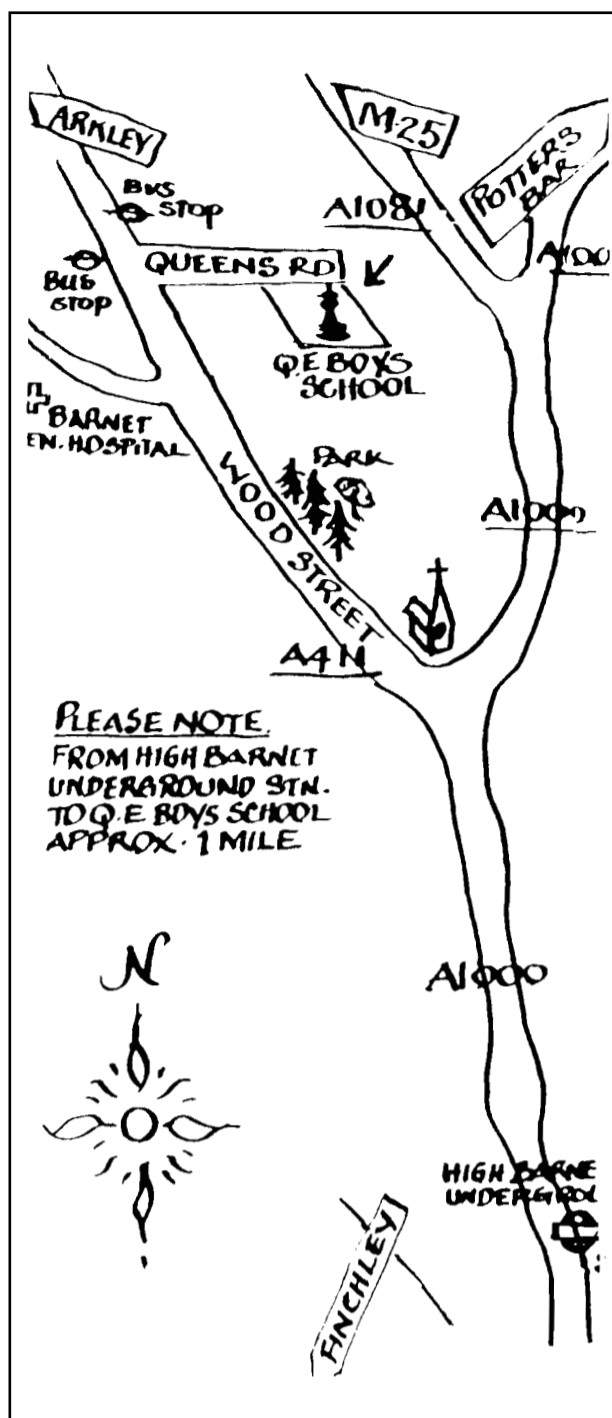

### PREMIER TOURNAMENT

For players graded 210 and below - entry fee £20  
Prizes £125, £75, £40. Grading prize (185 and below) £40.

### INTERMEDIATE TOURNAMENT

For players graded 160 and below - entry fee £18  
Prizes £80, £60, £40. Grading prize (135 and below) £40.

### MINOR TOURNAMENT

For players graded 110 and below - entry fee £16  
Prizes £70, £50, £30

*This tournament is recommended for newcomers to competitive chess.*

*BCF Direct members may deduct £2 from the entry fees.*

*Juniors (born since 31/8/1987) may deduct £3 from entry fees.*

*QE Boys School Pupils may enter for half the adult fee. A prize will be presented for the best performance by a QE School Pupil.*

### GRADES AND REFUSAL OF ENTRY

The organisers will have access to Grading Lists, and reserve the right to assign players to specific tournaments or to refuse entry.

### LATE FEES

There is a **late fee of £4** for entries postmarked after Sunday 15th January 2006, and a **late fee of £6** for entries received at the Congress, on the door.

### ARRIVAL

Early arrival is advised so that we can ensure pleasant playing conditions. This is particularly relevant to those not yet registered or paid.

### REPAIRING AND LATE ARRIVALS

Those players without an opponent will be repaired 30 minutes after the start of the round. The rate of play will be adjusted accordingly. We will endeavour to ensure all players get a game, even where there is an odd number.

Players not present after 30 minutes, will be deemed to have lost by default unless a suitable pairing can still be made.

### HALF POINT BYE

A half point bye will be granted in any of Rounds 1 to 4, if requested on the entry form.

### PRIZES

The organisers reserve the right to alter the prizes if the entries deem this appropriate.

No player can be awarded more than one prize.

No ungraded player may win a grading prize.

In the event of a tie, cash prizes will be shared.
